Item I lend to my loving wife Margery Whitney all my personal estate
not already given and all my negroes during her natural life or widowhood
but in case she is ever married again in that case I give all the
aforesaid estate together with the increase of my negroes if any in
the time to be equally divided between my loving wife Margery
Whitney and my four children to say Joshua Whitney & Editha
Whitney & Giles Whitney & Mary Whitney at the time of my wife's
marrying again but in case she do not marry any more I do lend
her the aforesaid estate during her natural life and after her decease to
be equally divided among my four children before mentioned the same to them
and their heirs forever.

Item I do hereby empower my executors hereafter named to acknowledge to Tho^s Lankford
of y^e Isle of White county or to his executors a good and lawful deed in fee simple
for all my land lying and being black water and black creek & joining to
John Lankford's land and William Butts for which land I have agreed to
or let him & said Thomas Lankford have it if he will or can for ye sum of
sixty pounds and money of thirty five pounds of y^e said money to be
paid on y^e first day of January next ensuing. y^e date hereof to remain in
part to be paid when the said Thomas Lankford will receive three
years after and I do hereby empower and require my executors to make to
y^e said Tho^s Lankford a good and sure right to y^e same at any times when
y^e said Tho^s Lankford shall require it.

Lastly I do hereby appoint my loving wife Margery Whitney and my friend
John Turner to be my whole and sole executors of this my last will and
testament revoking & disannulling all other wills made by me heretofore
made or declared as witness my hand and seal this eighteenth day of May 1762
