this 10 day of november 1762.

7 spoons four iron pots & 2 ft hooks 1 stone bottle 1 stone water jugg two stone  
muggs 1 white punch bowl 3 meat sifters one wooling wheel with 2 iron  
spindles 3 ft cards one ft stillards one gunn one hand saw 1 chiswells one  
auger one drawing knife knife and one from four axes six hoes two pilon  
hoes 2 chairs one squair table one bench & six stools eight old baskets four  
cyder hys heads six old barrells one meat bagg one old looking glasse  
table knives & 8 forks one box iron & heaters one grind stone one razor & 11  
and four files one pepper box 1 tin funnel one frying pan one mans saddle
