I give unto my sister Mary Hart twenty pounds current money

I give unto my Nease Elizabeth Hart ten pounds current money

I give unto my Cozen Robert Hart just five pounds current money

I give unto my Cozen John Washington five pounds current money

I give unto my loving wife Sarah Washington the land plantation whereon I now live during her life I further give unto my said wife the use of my five negroes Robin Dick Pompey Michel and Daniel during her life I further give unto my wife the use of all my stock of horses cattle sheep hoggs my household furniture and all utensils thereunto belonging during her life.

I give and bequeath unto my Cozen Joseph Washington and his wife Washington after the death of my wife the land plantation and negroes given her her life to have my said Cozen & the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever.

I give all the remainder of my estate of what nature so ever to my said Cozen Joseph Washington and lastly I do hereby appoint my said Cozen George Washington executor of this my last will and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
