Item Provided also my daughter Susanna should die before she comes of age or marries then I bequeath my lands in Brunswick to Nathaniel Parham to him his heirs and assigns forever I also desire that in case my wife should marry that then my daughter Rebecca's part of my sis stock &c should be put to my plantations in Brunswick & that to be continued by my executors untill she comes of age or marries towards the use and support of my said daughter Rebecca Thewatt.

And I do hereby appoint my beloved wife's executors and Nathaniel Parham executor of this my last will and testament revoking all others before by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this sixteenth day of March one thousand seven hundred and sixty three.

My will and desire is that my estate may not be appraised.
