All the remainder part of my estate of what nature or kind soever I give to be equally divided between my four children Viz: Benney Josiah McNamee and Peruna & lastly I appoint my loving wife Mary Johnson to be executrix to this my last will and testament revoking & annulling all other wills by me heretofore made desiring this only to be my last will as I witness my hand and seal this 20 day of the 8th month called August 1741.
