plantation whereon I now live with two hundred & thirty
acres of land joining it to him and his heirs forever
I likewise give unto John Bailey fifty acres more joining
it surveyed between Barnaby Bailey & I William Howell
which we have not yet the patent out to him this last
year I give the said lands

And I do appoint John Bailey my sole executor of this
