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last will and testament in manner & forme following that is to
say In witness I will and desire that all my just debts be paid
Then I lent to my dearly beloved wife Sarah the use of my plantation
and negro man York during her natural life & after her death
I give the land and negro fellow to my daughter Anne & the
heirs of her body lawfully begotten.

Then I give and bequeath to my daughter Anne the feather beds &
my negro girl Jenny and her heirs with thirty pounds
cash to her & her heirs forever.

Then My will and desire is that if my daughter Anne die
under age or without issue that all the lands & slaves
heretofore giving to my daughter Anne should bequeath to my
god son William Stephenson and his heirs forever.

Then I bequeath all the rest of my estate of what nature or
kind soever to my wife Sarah and after her death to my
daughter Anne (and her heirs forever).

And lastly I hereby appoint my wife John Bailey & Simon
Stephenson executors of this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this
24 day of March 1763.
