

the Lands & plantation whereon I now live containing one hundred & twenty five acres, also one hundred Acres of land Between the Hoive swamp & the broad swamp, I also give him my negro boy slave named Tom & my negro slave named Pat and one Desk to him and his heirs forever also one half of what ready money I have in the house -

I give devise & bequeath to my son Henry Johnson the plantation and all the land that I bought of John Onsey containing one hundred acres I also give him my two Negro Slaves Named York & Joe and my smiths tools with one half of the ready money that I have in the house to him and his heirs for ever

I give devise and bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca my negro Child slave named Jone to her & her heirs forever All the residue of my estate of what nature or kind soever after my wifes death or marriage I give to be equally divided between my three children Viz^t Matthew, Henry & Rebecca and to their heirs

and lastly I constitute and appoint my friend James Jordan Scott to be executor of this my last will and Testament as Witnesses my hand & seal this 23 day of January 1764 -

At a Court held for the county of Southampton the 24 day of March 1764
This Will was presented in court proved by the Oaths of Anne Johnson an solemnly affirmed to by James Jordan Scott he being one of the people called Quakers the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and the exor. therein named refusing to take the oath then of the execution thereof on the motion of Anne Johnson who made oath according to law certificate is granted her
