my will & devise is that all my just debts be paid—
I lend unto my loving Wife Lucy Little during her natural life the part of the plantation whereon I now live to be laid off and have Informed John Blunt, Baker Whit. & Wm Person with the following negroes, Jenny, Lucy, Britt, Bett & Tom. I give & bequeath to my said Wife three feather Beds & furniture

Item

I give & bequeath to my son William Little the upper part of my land on Mohoring River. Including so much of the land Strought of John Inman Junr. as followeth (to wit) beginning at a Pine in Persons line on the lower side of the round about thence a line of markt trees to the branch near my Plantation thence along the branch thence along the Branch between the Plantation Slivon & the plantation Strought of John Inman Junr. to the Gum log gutt thence a line of Marked trees to the mouth of a large gutt below my Tob. growing on Moharing River to him & his heirs forever

Item

I give & bequeath to my son John Little the lower part of all my lands on Moharing River Except that part I have lent to my wife during her natural life & that after her Death to him & his heirs forever—

Item

I leave all my negroes to be equally divided between my two sons William & John Little except those Negroes I lent to my wife during her life & them after her death to them & their heirs forever

Item

My will & devise is that all my lands not here before devised and all the remainder of my estate of what Nature or kind soever or where soever found to be void and the money arising to be applied towards discharging my just debts & do appoint
