 Thank to be given to Almighty God for the same, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following, first and principally I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator hoping through the merits of my blessed Saviour to attain Everlasting life, and as for my worldly Estate I give and bequeath in manner & form following—

Item

I leave to my loving Wife Jane Collier all my Estate both real and personal (to say) all my lands and negroes stock & household goods or any thing else of what kind or quality I leave to her during her natural life: and after her decease I give all my aforesaid estate to be equally divided among my three Daughters in Quantity and quality (to say) Rebecca Collier & Ann Collier & Sarah Collier: the same to them & their Heirs forever

but in case either of my aforesaid Childrens aforesaid dies before the come to lawfull age or without Heir in that case I give her part of my estate to be equally divided between her mother her Sisters then living the same to them and their Heirs forever
