

- the plantation whereon I now live. Likewise I give him one negro boy named Samy one young mare called Fly, one negro bridle and saddle all and every part thereof I give to him his heirs and assigns forever. —
- Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my son Richard Ricks the land bounded as followeth beginning at a pine a corner tree of Richard Ricks land then running a straight line across the Huckleberry plantation to the head of Buttons branch then down the said branch to a whitemake from thence to flag swamp then down the said swamp to a Cypress a corner tree of Richard Ricks line then round the said Ricks line to the beginning likewise I give him one negro boy named Jack all and every part of both land and negro I give to him and to his heirs and assigns forever.
- Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Ricks all my land on the south side of Cowcory Branch that I have not already given away likewise one negro boy named Ned all and every part of both land and negro I give to him and to his heirs and assigns forever.
- Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Ricks one negro girl named Lucy to her and to her heirs and assigns forever likewise I give her five pounds each.
- Seventhly I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Helen Ricks one negro girl named Sarah to her and to her heirs and assigns forever likewise I give her five pounds each. —
- Eighthly I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Anne Ricks one negro girl named Jane to her and to her heirs and assigns forever likewise I give her five pounds each. —
- Ninthly I leave all the remainder of my estate to be sold and after my just debts are paid I give all the remainder to be equally divided between my two sons Richard & Joseph to them and to their heirs and assigns forever. —
- Tenthly I implore my wife and my son Thomas Ricks my full and sole executor and Executor to see this my last will and Testament performed in every whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of the seventh Month and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and four.
