Item I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Clements the plantation
I now live upon containing three hundred and ten acres at
my wife's decease or marriage likewise one negro boy called Lewis
at the age of twenty one years and one bed and furniture and
the fifth part of my stock and likewise a negro boy called
Duke at my wife's decease or marriage

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Judy one negro girl
called Amy at the age of eighteen years of age married one
negro boy called Ned at my wife's death or marriage and the
fifth part of my stock and one bed and furniture.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary at my wife's death
or marriage Jammy Hannah and Pats at the age of sixteen one
bed and furniture and the fifth part of my stock and likewise
at my wife's death I desire Jeffry may be sold and the money -
arising from the said sale may equally be divided amongst my
four children Jammy, Thomas Clements, Judy & Mary and all the
remainder part of my estate after my just debts are paid
I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Lucy and to her
disposal let it be of what nature or quality ever and I
do likewise constitute and ordain my loving Father Thomas
Gilliam and my friend Benjamin Clements Jr and my loving
wife Lucy my whole and sole executors of this my last
will and testament and I do hereby utterly disallow work -
and desavow all and every other former testaments will legacies
and bequests and executors by me in any wise before made
named wills or bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and
no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first
above written
