feather bed & furniture my silver hilted sword one gold ring & fifty
pounds current together with all the profits that shall or doth arise
from the partnership with Charles Briggs also all the stock of what
nature or kind soever belonging to the said plantation -

Item I Give unto my daughter Elizabeth Briggs the following negroes
Charles Franky & Abigail also one gold ring & forty pounds current
money to her & her heirs forever -

Item I Give unto my daughter Martha Blon the following negroes (to wit)
Sam. Jemmy Amy & Hannah also one horse saddle & bridle one feather bed
& furniture one gold ring & fifty pounds current money to her & her
heirs for ever -

Item I Give unto my daughter Lucy Blon the following negroes Jac. ^{the} David
Young Charity & Daniel also one horse saddle one feather bed & furniture
one gold ring & fifty pounds current money to her & her heirs for ever -

Item I Give unto my daughter Mary Blon the following negroes (to wit)
Milly Judah Lucy & Jacob also one horse & saddle & bridle one feather bed
& furniture one gold ring & fifty pounds to her & her heirs for ever -

Lastly I Give unto my loving wife after my just debts & legacies are paid
all the remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever during
her life & after her death my will & desire is that the said remainder
be equally divided amongst all my children I do hereby constitute & ap-
point my son Richard Blon & my son in law Charles Briggs executors
of this my last will & testament & further that they may not be requir-
ed by the court to give security for my estate be so provided. In witness
