I Give and bequeath to my brother Jesse Washington two hundred acres of land more or less bounded as my father's will directs to him & his heirs for ever

I Give to my sister Faith Washington eight pounds cash.

I Give to my sister Mary Washington eight pounds cash

I Give to my brother Jesse Washington all the remainder of my estate to him & his heirs for ever

I Do nominate & appoint my brother Jesse Washington executor of this my last will & testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 13th Day of Octo. 1757
