reserving his mother's life therein also I Give to him one negro girl slave
named Rose Jane negro man slave named Tomy only reserving to his
mother the use & profit of the said slave till the day of her marriage
with also one feather bed and furniture one horse bridle & saddle & three
year old heifers & one gun to him and his heirs for ever - - - - -

of five shillings current money to her & her heirs - - - - -

negro man slave named Will to him and his heirs for ever - - - - -

of five shillings current money to her & her heirs - - - - -
- Item I Give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Judith Joyner one
negro boy slave named Robin and feather bed & furniture & one cow
