 cattle & hogs & sheep & my will & desire is that all the rest of my estate
 whatsoever & wheresoever not already willd away I give unto my son

 friends Joshua Whitney & my son Jesse Bull whole & sole exors of this
 my last will & testament revoking all other former wills & testaments
