In the name of God amen I Jas. Turner of Southampton county being
in health of body but calling to mind the uncertainty of human life do
make & approve this to be my last will & testament

I Begueath my soul to Almighty God that gave it hoping to receive a
joyful resurrection of the same & my body to be buried at the discretion
of my executors hereafter mentioned & as to what worldly goods it hath
pleased God to bestow on me I dispose of them as follows

I Give to my son James the lower part of my land to be devised as follows
to wit) Beginning at a Barren White oak standing in a Bottom in the
County line near opposite to his dwelling house then running a straight
course to a corner white oak & Hickory in a pond at the head of Jacobs
branch including all the lower part of my land that is below
the aforesaid division to him & his heirs forever

I Give to my son Jacob the plantation he now lives on together with
my mill & all my land of the north side of the Flat Swamp to him &
his heirs forever — I Give to my son Jacob a survey of land lying
Batycaisy swamp in Northampton county on the lower side of
the Great Branch to him & his heirs forever I Give to my son
