

James Turney names Tom one neg; man named Ben one neg; girl named Lisday to him & his heirs for ever — — —

I give to my daughter Eliz^a my plantation on Browns branch called Casari & all my land there to adjoining that is on the north side of Brownson branch to her & her heirs for ever I give to my daughter Elizabeth one neg; woman named Rose ^{that she} now in possession together with the increase that she has or hereafter shall have to her & her heirs for ever —

I give to my son Wm after his mothers death the plantation whereon I now live & all the remainder of my land thereunto adjoining to him & his heirs for ever. I give to my son Wm my plantation & five hundred & forty acres of land on Boty easy stream in Northampton county whereon I lived & lived to live to him & his heirs for ever I give to my son Wm the following negroes (to wit) Casari his two children Tom & Sarah Dick & his Cooper & Frank to him & his heirs for ever —

I give to my son Thomas 50 pounds of money of Virginia & I give him what money he is indebted to me

I give to my son John three negroes that he has in possession Frank & Betsy & Betsy & all their increase that they have had since he had them in possession or hereafter shall have to him & his heirs for ever —

I leave to my loving wife Anne my plantation whereon I now live also the following negroes Sam Freeman Cid & Solomon for & during her natural life & after her decease I give the said negroes & their increase from this time forward to my son Wm & his heirs for ever all the rest of my estate I leave to my loving wife Anne during her life & after her decease what is then remaining I give to my son Wm & I do appoint my son James Jacob & William Executors to this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills formerly by me made & do ordain this to be my last In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 18 Day of July 1763
