Item I Give & bequeath to my son John all my lands lent to my wife
after her decease together with all the lands lying between
Little asphians lines & the lower line or bounds of the land
lent to my wife as far as to my line above the bushy neck
also forty acres of land lying between W^m Blunt's line & John
Persons line all the above mentioned land I give to my son John
to him & his heirs for ever — — — — —

Item I give to my son Anthony all the rest of my lands lying in
Southampton county not heretofore devised to him & his
heirs forever

Them I gave of Bequeth to my son W^m all the lands belonging to me in North Carolina to him & his heirs for ever also the following negroes (to wit) Ben. Clary, Little Ned, & Edy & their increase in case he shall arrive to the age of twenty one Years to him & his heirs for ever. otherwise to remain at the rest of my estate & undivided & in case of the death of my son William before he arrive to the age of twenty one Years my will & desire is that the said negroes be equally divided among my wife & all my children that shall be then living to each of them their respective parts & to their heirs for ever - - -

I do leave all the rest of my slaves & personal estate after my just debts are paid to remain on my Manor plantation in the possession of my executors for the use of my wife & all my children until my eldest son living shall attain to the age of twenty one years or my wife shall marry at which time I give all my slaves & increase to my together with all the rest of my personal estate & the profits thereof left in the hands of my executors to be equally divided among my wife all my children that shall be then living their respective parts to them & their heirs for ever & I do appoint my loving wife Mary Day Risley of Wirtford county North Carolina executors of this my last will & testament hereby revoking all other wills formerly by me made & do appoint Godwin Trust to be my last In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 17th day of June 1792.
