First I give & bequeath my soul to God that gave it surely trusting through the mediation of my blessed saviour Jesus Christ to receive the same at the general resurrection & my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors herein after named & as for my real and personal estate I give & dispose of it in manner & form following

I give & bequeath unto John Thomas Blount son of Richard Blount deceased all that plantation containing one hundred acres whereon Arthur Sellers formerly dwelt also all my land & plantation whereon I now dwell and all the stock of horses cattle hogs & sheep thereunto belonging as also part of my land purchased of the Indians lying & being on the south side of the Great Branch bounded by the said branch. Charman road & the head line to him & his heirs for ever as also the following negroes Scipio & Jimmy & after the death of Elizabeth Inman I give him the following negroes Viz. Jeffery Hannah & James & Tom to him & his heirs forever also I give & bequeath unto the said John Thomas Blount my desk & sea chest Bed & furniture thereunto belonging & four leather & bottom chairs
