heirs forever also the following negroes Dick Phillip Phillis
& Will also I give him one feather bed & furniture & four
leather bottoms chairs to be delivered to him at the age of
eighteen Years

Item

I give and bequeath unto James Vaughan son of Henry
Vaughan one negro girl called Easter to him & his heirs for
ever to be delivered to him when ~~she~~ he arrives to the
age of twenty one Years

Item

I give and bequeath unto Henry Vaughan son of Henry Vaughan
one negro girl names Lucy to him and his heirs for ever
to be put in possession thereof as soon as he arrives to the
age of twenty one years

Item

I give & bequeath unto Mary Briggs Vaughan daughter
of the said Henry Vaughan one negro girl names Sarah
to her & her heirs for ever to be delivered to her at the age of eight
teen Years or day of marriage which of them shall first happen

Item

I give & bequeath to Thomas Vaughan son of said Henry Vaughan
part of the land purchased of the Indians & the plantation
therunto belonging lying & being on the North side of the Great Branch
bounded by the said Branch & Benjamin Evans line & the head
line to him & his heirs forever to receive the same at the age of
twenty one Years

I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Triman the wife of said my
plantation with the land & houses & following negroes J^{ff}
Hannah James & Tom during her life & after the death of all my
stock of cattle hogg & sheep also all my Household goods & her
to use as she shall think ^{most} proper for the maintenance of herself
