Lastly I make and ordain John Thomas Blon & Elizabeth Inman my full & sole executrix & executrix of this my last will & testament but in case of the death of the said Elizabeth Inman I do appoint Henry Vaughan trustee to see this my will performed In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 4th day of April 1763
