 bought of Joshua Pope & one hundred & seven acres a patent
 formerly granted to William Barnes on the west side of Blunt
 swamp aforesaid. I give the use of to my wife ^{& daughters} & after the death
 or marriage of my wife & daughters each & every of them I give the
 said plantation house & lands that are already mentioned in
 this legacy unto my son Samuel Edmund & his heirs forever in
 case my son Samuel Edmund die under the age of twenty years
 or without issue I give the said lands to my son Thomas Edmund
 & his heirs forever I like wise give the use of three hundred & ninety
 acres of land I bought of the Nottoway Indians joining John &
 Andrew Pops lands to wife & daughters as aforesaid & after
 their Yeare of their death or marriage I give the said tract of
 land to my son Thomas Edmund & his heirs forever
