money of Virginia & also the money due me in the hands of

I Give and bequeath to my son John Edmunds & his heirs
for ever all my land I bought of James Cravey in Wchurris
river Northampton county but in case my son John Edmunds
die under the age of twenty one years & without issue I leave
the said land to be sold to the highest bidder by my execs giving
twelve months Credit & the purchase money to be equally divided
between my sons Wm & Samuel & my wife & unmarried daugh-
ters (to wit) Sarah Mary Ann Martha & Lucy I also give my
son John Edmunds & his heirs forever four negroes (to wit)
Frank Joe Pannaah & her child Nat one feather bed & furniture
twenty head of cattle four sows & pigs & all the utensils on
my upper quarter also one mare called his & one saddle & bridle
& also one horse called Tolly

Item

I Give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Edmunds & his heirs
for ever all the remaining part of my lands on the west side of the Indian
line containing sixteen hundred & twenty acres be the same more
or less with the appurtenances thereon & in case my son Samuel
die under the age of twenty one years & without issue I give
the said lands to my son Thomas Edmunds & his heirs for
ever I also give my son Samuel Edmunds twenty head of
cattle four sows & pigs & all the utensils on my lower quarter
one feather bed & furniture one young horse saddle & bridle & fifty
pound current money of Virginia I also give to my son Samuel
Edmunds after his mothers death or marriage my water grist
mill to him & his heirs forever provided he live to the age of
twenty one years or leaves issue but in case my son Samuel die
under age or without issue I give the & water grist mill to my
son Thomas Edmunds & his heirs for ever
