of my estate I give the use of it to my wife her life time & after
her death to be equally divided amongst my four youngest
children or the survivors of them

And Lastly I nominate & appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Adams
& son Henry Adams exors & executors of this my last
will & testament hereby revoking & making void all other wills
& testaments by me at any time heretofore made In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fourth
day of September Anno Domini 1767

At a Court held for the county of Southampton the 8. Day
of March 1770 This will was presented
in Court by Henry Adams one of the executors therein named

said executors who made oath according to law certificate is
