 County of Southampton being of sound & disposing mind & memory
 do make & give in this my last will & testament as follows I pray
 after recommending my soul to God & my body to the Earth to
 be buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter named —

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Stephenson the
 plantation wherein I now live containing one hundred & five acres be
 the same more or less & half my cattle half my hogs & half my
 sheep after his mothers decease & my several coll to him & his
 heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Esther Brown wife of
 Jeph^t Brown one feather bed & furniture to her & her heirs
 for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Celah Stephenson one Bed
 & furniture one chest to her & her heirs for ever

Item I give unto my son Simon Stephenson one Cow & calf & all my
 cloths both Linen & Woolen to him & his heirs for ever
