In the name of God Amen I George Wood of the Parish of Mottoway &
County of Southampton being sick and weak but of perfect and sound mind and
memory do make this my last will & Testament revoking all former wills by
me made in manner & form following to wit

I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Wood one feather bed & furniture, to
her & her heirs forever. I also give unto my wife the use of the plantation wherein
I now live and the use & labour of the following slave, during her natural life
to wit, Peter, Henry & Daniel and after my wife's decease I give the said
negroes Peter, Henry & Daniel to my Daughter Mary Bailey & her heirs
forever

I give and bequeath unto my son Joshua Wood one negro fellow named
Jacob to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Bailey my negro boy named
Harry to her & her heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my son Moses Wood my negro boy named Dennis
during his natural life and after his decease I give the said negro Dennis
to my Grand son George Wood son of Mary Wood to him & his heirs forever

I further give unto my son Moses Wood three cows & calves to him & his heirs forever
I give & bequeath unto my Grand Son Richard Bailey one negro boy
named Dick to him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my Grand son Thomas Wood Son of Henry Wood
Deceased one negro boy named Roger to him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Lucy Bailey one negro girl
named Chloe to her & her heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mary Wood Daughter of
Benjamin Wood deceased thirty pound Cash to her & her heirs forever

My will & desire is that after my just debts & legacies are paid, all the
remainder of my Estate of what nature or kind soever be equally di-
vided amongst my three Children & two Grand Children (that is

Joshua Wood Moses Wood & Mary Bailey & my two Grand Children
Thomas Wood & Mary Wood children of Henry Wood Deceased) I further desire

& direct that the Land & plantation wherein I now live after my wife's decease be
sold for the best price that can be had & the money arising therefrom to be equally

divided as above that is to say between my sons and my daughter
Mary Bailey & my two Grand Children Thomas & Mary Wood after

their lives —

Sothly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Joshua Wood
and my son in Law Barnaby Bailey Executors of this my last

will & Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal the 13 Day of Sept 1770
