one negro man named Ned which he has now in possession also
one negro man named Stephen with twenty pounds current
money to him & his heirs

I give unto my son Ma thew Jones
unto my son Joseph Jones the plantation whereon he now dwells
with all the lands thereunto belonging containing four hundred
acres land to him & his heirs forever I give unto my son Joseph
one negro man named Cupid which he has now in possession

Item

also one negro ^{man} named Harry & twenty pounds current money to him
& his heirs It is my will desire that my loving wife Elizabeth
Jones do live & dwell with my son Samuel Jones & I have the
use of her choice of the rooms of the house that I now dwell in
during her life with two good feather beds & furniture with other
things sufficient to furnish the ^{two} rooms & further my will is that
my son Samuel pay unto my wife Elizabeth seven pounds current
money a year during her life & after her death then over & above remain
to return & be given to my son Samuel Jones and his heirs

Item

I give the quarter unto my son Samuel Jones the plantation whereon
he now dwells and all the lands thereunto belonging containing six
hundred & seventy two acres be the same more or less to him & his heirs forever

Item

I give unto my son Samuel two negroes to wit Sam & Harry to him & his
heirs forever I give unto my son Samuel all the real & personal
estate goods & chattels both within doors & without to him & his heirs
It is my will & desire that if either my son Joseph or Samuel should die
before they enter into the state of marriage then the lands of the said
brother to be sole of the money arising from the sale thereof to be equally
divided between the surviving brother & sister lastly I do constitute
& appoint my son Samuel Jones sole & sole executor of this my
last will & testament touching disposing of making void
all other wills hereof now made by me Witness my hand & affixed
seal this 30 day of May 1770
