child named Noy, my black riding horse & saddle also I give
that my Brother Moses Booth may have the care of him
& his estate till he arrive to 21 years of age

I give & devise to my daughter Lucy & to her heirs forever one neg^r
girl named Judy also one good feather bed & furniture

I give & devise to my daughter Sarah & to her heirs forever
negro girl named Hannah

I give & devise to my daughter Martha & to her heirs forever
one neg^r girl named Annika

Also my will & devise is that after all my Just debts being p^d
the remainder & residue of my estate be equally divided among
all my children as aforementioned I likewise constitute and
appoint my son James & Brother Moses Booth Executors
of this my last will & testament
