 basar, Billy, Willy & Doll together with their furniture & moveables
 to him my son Samuel this heirs for ever
- Also I give & bequeath unto my grandson Jesse Brown this heirs of his body
 lawfully begotten forever all my lands lying & being on the Indian
 branch on Catawby swamp in the County of Guilford Province
 of North Carolina likewise all my books of Physick & Surgery my
 instruments of Surgery & all my Medicines my riding horse & milking
 furniture consisting of Swords Saddle & other caparisons & other
 unto properly belonging my Clock Watch & still ^{case} & desk & book case
- Also I give unto my said grandson Jesse Brown this heirs forever one tract
 of land containing 100 Acres be the same more or less lying between the
 plantation herein after devised to the heirs of my daughter Ridley
 Taylor & Wottoway River being part of the land bought of the Mills
- Also I give unto my said grandson Jesse Brown this heirs forever one other tract
 of land lying in the parish of Luke County of N. York which is
 tract & parcel of Joseph Strickling & which was patented by
 Oliver Woodard
- Also I give unto my grandson Jesse Brown this heirs forever the following
 slaves to wit their furniture & moveables to wit / Frank, Jacob, Venus, Army, Brutus
 London, Billy, Will, old Pompey, Dinah & Phillis
- Also I give & bequeath unto my trusty friend my executor, herein after named
 for the use & purposes herein after mentioned the following Negroes together
 with their furniture & moveables to wit / Jack, Hoony, Hercules, George & Doll
 which is Doll I purchased of W. Taylor & which is Doll & Hoony
 I have for some time past lent the use of to my daughter Ridley Taylor
- Also I further give & bequeath unto my trusty friend my executor for the use
 & purposes herein after mentioned the plantation whereon Rachel
 Taylor now lives beginning on the North side of Wottoway River at the
 head of the broad branch or gully down the various Meanders of said
 branch by the plantation to Wottoway River & down Wottoway River
 to Hines's line along a line to Cobbs line from Cobbs's Whitechapel line
 along Whitechapel to a corner tree standing at Davis's landing about
 thence down the River to the first station which stands at the place
 in the foregoing devise and to remain in trust with my said executor
