Will This my last and testament revoking all former wills by me
made in manner and form following

Impt I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Patience Alkinson the
Use of all my personal Estate of what nature or kind soever
during her Natural life than to be equally divided amongst my
Children (that is to say) Thomas, James, Ann, Nathan, Celia,
Sarah, Easter, Lucy, Michael, and Priscilla.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Thomas Alkinson all my Land on the
East side of the Miry Branch running from Head of the miry
Branch to Jeremys Hill, thence down the Meadow Branch to him
and his Heirs forever, provided he pay my son James five pounds.
I give and bequeath the aforesaid Land to my son James and his
Heirs forever on his paying my son Thomas five pounds.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Michael Alkinson the plantation
whereon I now live and all my Land lying on the west
side of the miry Branch to him and his Heirs forever
provided he pay my son Nathan five pounds Current
money. I do hereby constitute and appoint my loving
Wife and my son Thomas my whole and sole Executors
of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first
