Men once to die and not knowing how soon I therefore make and
Ordain this my last Will and Testament.

I give and bequeath my Soul into the hands of God that gave it me
and rest my Body to be Buried in a decent and Christian like
manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned
And for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to Bless me with all
after all my just Debts and funeral Expences paid I give and dispose
The rest of my Estate in the manner and form as followeth.

I give and Bequeath to my beloved Wife Martha Williams
one Feather Bed and furniture And then I lend to my said
Wife Martha the use of one Room in the Dwellinghouse
of which she may Choose. and likewise I lend to my daughter
Martha Williams the liberty of the same Room together with
my wife Martha as long as my said Daughter lives unmarried

I give and bequeath to my son Isaac Williams and his heirs or
Assigns for ever the plantation and lands whereon I now live,
