I give and bequeath unto my sister Sarah Willons my Negro girl Rose and her increase to her and her heirs for ever.

I also give unto my said sister three cows and Calves one Chest three chairs three pewter dishes one trunk and one Iron

I give and Bequeath unto my niece Patience James all the Money I have which about nineteen pounds ten shillings, my saddle and six shillings and three pence due me from her husband John James.

I give and bequeath unto Pamela Wood Daughter of Moses Wood one Feather bed and furniture.

My Will and desire is that all the residue of my Estate of what Nature or kind soever be given my sister Sarah Willons except My wearing apparel and them I desire may be divided between My sister Sarah Willons Mary Wood, wife of Moses Wood Patience James and Sarah Booth Daughter of Arthur Booth dece. agreeable to the directions I shall leave with my Brother Moses Booth whom I do hereby constitute and appoint Executor of this my last Will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of July 1771.
