appointed for all or to die do make and ordain this my last
will & Testament in manner & form following first of all I give
my Soul to Almighty that gave it & my body to be buried at the
discretion of my Exors hereafter named & touching all
worldly goods I have disposed as follows

I give & bequeath unto my Loving Mother Mary Edmunds
Ther heirs four five Negroes to wit Jeffery Edith Ben Jeph & Kate
also all the remaining part of my Estate of what kind soever
I also constitute and appoint my loving mother Mary
Edmunds whole & sole Exors of this my last Will & Testament

& Year first above written
