

up to within 300 yards of Charles Bapes house on the main run of the creek
thence a straight line to where the said Robins branch enters the lower end
of the said creek to him the said John Thorpe to his heirs forever likewise
give and devise to my said son John my still & Minnegrass to wit / Old her
young her George Jeffrey Simon Jacob Judith Well & Amy to him and
his heirs forever also one feather bed & furniture this legacy of Negro to my
son John is on the condition that my said son John is to pay unto my
daughter Media Spence one hundred dollars & in case of my said son
refusing to pay or delay in paying the said one hundred Dollars unto
my said daughter Media the said six months after this my will
is proved in court and ordered to be recorded then my will &
desire is that as much of my said son John's legacy shall be paid
as will raise the said one hundred dollar and the same to be
delivered to my said daughter Media.

Item I likewise give and bequeath to my said son John the north part of
land I purchased of James Westbrook bounded on the South side
from the head of a Meadow of a small run that William
Johnson has a pond on a straight line to the north corner of Arthur
Matthews fence to him the said and to his heirs forever

Item William Johnson has purchased a parcel of land of me and has
given me a bond for the purchase money and chosen I shall give
him the said land in this said Will In compliance therewith
I give and devise to the said William Johnson the south part
of my land I bought of James Westbrook bounded on the north or divide
by the line mentioned in my son John's ^{last} legacy from the head of the meadow
of a run whereon the said Johnson has a pond to the North corner of
Arthur Matthews ^{bounded by estimation to be one hundred acres}
to him the said Johnson & to his heirs forever

Item I give the labors of my negro girl Jane to my daughter Drucilla Thomas
during her natural life and after her decease I give and bequeath to
my granddaughter Famer Barlow the said negro girl Jane and all her movables
to her and heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Harris two negroes Doll and Harry
to her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Reese my Negro boy Cain to her
and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Olive Reese three Negroes Dorcas Ben
and Simeon to her and her heirs forever

N.B. some years ago I gave a negro girl to my grand Randolph Harris (call
Tydia) she is now under the care of my son in law Lewis Harris & to
her person she gift me. I give to the said Randolph Harris the Negro
