I give & bequeath to my son James Jones the plantation wherein I now live from the high hill line that bought of Thomas Ridley as low down as to a white oak at the Lower End of John Coopers old field & where Sains Line joined & towards & from astrait line to the Mouth of a Branch that Enters itself into the Angillio swamp at the Beaver Pond about Three Hundred yds above the Angillio Bridge which sd Land I give to my sd & to his heirs forever —

Item

I give & bequeath to my son Abraham Parkam Jones the land that I purchased of Trathy Lane with all the lower part of my land which I now live on that was not heretofore devised to my son James Jones which sd Land I give to my sd son Abraham Parkam Jones & to his heirs forever —

Item

I give & bequeath to my son Richard Jones all the land I purchased of Thomas Ridley known by the name of the high hill which sd Land I give to my sd son & to his heirs forever —

Item

I give & bequeath to my son David Jones all the Land that I own on the North side of the Three Creeks togeth with what land I own on the south side of the Creek that lies below the deep bottom which sd Land I give to my son David Jones & to his heirs forever —

Item

My Will & desire is that all my Estate of What kind or nature so ever or where so ever found not heretofore devised be sold and after all my just debts is paid then the Remainder to be equally divided among all my Children that be living at that Time each of them Their Respective parts & to their heirs forever also my Will & desire is that all the Guardians of my Children if any if not My Executors to have power to purchase out of my Estate such slaves or other things that shall be thought of An advantage to the said Children —

Item

it is my will & desire that my Estate shall not be appraised Lastly I ordain constitute and appoint my sons Robert Jones James Jones & my son in law John Simmon my Executor hereby Revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made & Declared this to be my only Last will and Testament in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Fiftenth day of Dec. 1771
