I give and Bequeath unto my son William Moore One half of
this Land I have in North Carolina & the whole to be divided
between my said son William & my son John but if either of them
dies without heir the whole Land shall fall to William or his

Item

Moore I also give unto my son William Moore Negroes
Charles & Pig to him & his heirs

Item

I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Moore the land that I have
in Southampton County upon the three Creeks also Negroes
Joshua & Jinny to him and his heirs

Item

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Moore Negroes
Grace & Lucy to her & her heirs
