I give to my three Grand Children — Mary Ann Turner & John Williamsons Children of Exum Williamson one Negro woman named Fanny with her Increase from December one thousand seven hundred and sixty eight and one Negro Boy named Lewis to be equally divided between them —

I also give to my wife the use of the following Negroes During her Life. Sam Bob Mingo Charles & Beck and after her Death I give Mingo to my son Arthur and Bob to my son Jesse and Sam to my Daughter Mary and Charles to my Grandson Frances Williamson son of Exum Williamson — I further give to my wife two Feather Beds and furniture one Square Walnut Table my Grey Mare Saddle and Bridle and half a Doz. pewter Dishes one Doz. plates one large pine Chest and flowered Trunk half a doz. Chairs one doz. Spoons a brass Kettle one Iron pot one frying pan three Cows and Calves two heifers one Looking glass Linnen and wooling wheels my Loom and all the gear thereunto belonging —
