7th Item, I bequeath to my beloved wife Mahala Crumpler all of my stock of hogs, and Cattle, at hand at my death to her during her natural life and at her death I give the remaining stock of hogs and Cattle to Joshua Crumpler's and Emaline C. Bell's living children, to them and their heirs forever.

8th Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mahala Crumpler all of my stock of horses unto her and her heirs forever.

9th Item, I bequeath unto my beloved wife Mahala Crumpler all the residue of my Estate after taking out the debts and legacies aforementioned in my personal Estate by my Executrix hereinafter named and the residue to her during her natural life and at her death to Joshua Crumpler's and Emaline C. Bell's living children to them and their heirs forever.

I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Mahala Crumpler my lawful Executrix to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and Testament hereby reciting and declaring utterly void all other Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made.
