J. & Thos. Francis, whereas Thos. Francis is believed to be attached solely in explanation, the Exor assumed the Com. that the debt was compromised during the existence of the "stay law," when it was considered prudent, by reason of the very unceremonious state of affairs, and his ignorance at time of the solemnity and of the duty to the bond. The amount credited by him in said compromise is credited to the Estate in said Supplemental acc.
