 considering the Uncertainty of this frail and transitory life, do hereby
 make known publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament
 that is to say First after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged
 the residue of my Estate real and personal I give and bequeath and dispose
 of as follows, First I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha H.
 Turner the sum of five Dollars to her and her heirs forever.
 The residue of my Estate real and personal which I have not disposed of
 my will and desire is that it should be divided between the following
 persons (to wit) my son George H. Turner I give one half and
 one half to be equally divided between Benjamin H. Turner and James
 E. H. Turner. I make and constitute my son George H. Turner my
 whole and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament hereby
 revoking all former Wills made in respect whereof I have
 heretofore subscribed my name and affixed my seal this
 17th day of August One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Six

At a Court held for the County of Dorchester at the Court house thereof
 on the 18th day of January A.D. 1875. This last will and Testament of
 Elizabeth H. Turner dec. was shown by the Oaths of James R. Dixon
 and J. A. Musgrave the subscribing witnesses, who swore that it was
 ordered to be recorded. And George H. Turner the Executor
 thereof appeared refusing to take upon himself the burden of the exec-
 ution thereof on the motion of Joseph B. Prince, who together with
 Joseph H. Prince (his deputy) who justified on Oath as to his
 sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the
 penalty of Nine Thousand Dollars, conditioned as the law directs,
 which Bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted
 the said Joseph B. Prince for obtaining letters of administration
 on the Estate of the said Elizabeth H. Turner dec. with her
 will annexed in due form.
