At the request of the Executor the Commissioner states specially, that the Deceased died on April 6th 1871, having planted a portion of his crops, but leaving no money, and not sufficient provisions or funds to carry out their cultivation. Inasmuch as the land (the most of it of any value) had been devised to the Deceased's widow, the Executor consented that the said widow should have all she could make of the said crops. She therefore cultivated and planted at her own expense, raised and fattened the hogs, at her own expense, and delivered to the Executor all of the pork except what was a reasonable allowance to her in pursuance of the will - all of which is approved by the Commissioner.

The Receipt of the widow Rhoda W. Cott (now Channel) for the personal property bequeathed to her by the will is herewith filed (marked A) as part of this Report.
