At a Court held for the County of Southampton, on the 17th day of July 1876. This last Will and Testament of Ann P. Judkins dec. was proved by
Clerk of Charles E. C. Sprinkle, one of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and

sworn as a witness touching the handwriting of the said Parkman
