

during my lifetime, made him & died, I value at Seven Thousand dollars, and in the distribution of my Estate, I desire that he shall be charged on his account as one of my debts for the above land, at that valuation, in an acknowledgment.

Item 6th, I give to my son Joseph to keep & his heirs forever, my Secretary place, with his residence & the farm there attached, including some hundred acres of land for which I have made him a deed, during my lifetime, I value at Seven Thousand dollars, & in the distribution of my Estate, I desire that he shall be charged on his account as one of my debts, for the above, at that valuation, as an acknowledgment.

Item 7th, I give to my Daughters Sally H. Pope & Lalla M. Pope, equally to them & their heirs forever, my Secretary or White House farm, situated on Anthony River, near Jerusalem; This farm I value at ten thousand dollars. I further give in fee to the said Sally H. & Lalla M. Pope, Three thousand dollars, each, in money; & this devise these two Daughters have, each, five thousand dollars in value, of land, & each, Three thousand dollars in money, making Eight thousand dollars, each, a difference of one thousand dollars more than I have given to my son R. B. Pope. This difference I have made in account of my sons farms being a fine up and in account of their Education being completed.

Item 8th, I give to my son Charles R. Pope & his heirs forever, the whole of my 'Brown Place' which I value at Seven thousand dollars, I also give him in fee Two thousand dollars in money, making with the valuation of his Land, Nine thousand dollars, the difference here made is attributed to raising given in latter part of Item 7th and I have further given him One thousand dollars more than my daughter Sally & Lalla, to complete his Education.

Item 9th, I give to my son Thomas J. Pope, at the death of my wife, to him & his heirs forever, my home place, with the Land there attached, as set forth in Item 4th. I further give him in fee my gold watch & four thousand dollars in money. The farm of which I value at Seven thousand dollars; The reason why I have given this child four thousand dollars in money is, he may not come into possession of his Land for a long time, & I wanted to provide against such a contingency.

Item 10th, I give to my Daughter Maria Len Pope, & her heirs forever, the whole of my Richard Garden place, formerly owned by W. H. Nicholas, the old R. Garden place on the Jerusalem Road, and my farm known as the Acum place; I value these farms at Six thousand dollars, I also give her in fee Three thousand dollars in money; she being the youngest child, I have added in the gift of three thousand dollars, Two thousand dollars, for her Education, and One thousand dollars to make her land make up Seven thousand dollars, in valuation.

Item 11th, After the aforementioned debts are fully paid, I give to One Mary Jane Harrison Smith, in fee Five hundred dollars, in money, the said party was formerly of this County, but is now in Ohio, Married.

Item 12th, I desire that my Executors, Sell as soon as practicable, on such terms as they may think best, all my Estate not herein
