James M. Corbett, Betsey, James M. Corbett, Mary, John and her
heirs, Mary M. Corbett, Frances M. Corbett, Mary
James, and Betsey, each living child of Robert Corbett, Esq.
and Martha J. Corbett, one share for Sarah Catherine
Corbett, two equal shares.

I^{4th} It is my will and desire that I should any of the above
mentioned heirs die without leaving lawfully begotten heirs,
that their legacies should revert back to myself.

I^{5th} It is my will and desire that my son James M.
Corbett be my executor to this my last will and testament
and Guardian to my grand children without paying value
and to settle up with them as far as they shall beget any
from under my hand and seal this 31st day of July 1878.

and in the presence of two thousand Dollars
(conditioned as the law directs, which two
orders to be recorded. Certificate is made
the said James M. Corbett has obtained
