Whereas all men by these presents, That I John Lewis Edwards of the County of Shenandoah, State of Virginia, being in full sound mind and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any heretofore made. And as to my worldly estate, and all the property real and personal, or mixed, of which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease, I do hereby request and desire thereof, in the manner following to wit:
First, my will is, that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall be paid out of my estate, as soon after my decease as shall be found convenient.
Then, I give, devise and bequest to Miss Sarah Jane Williams her heirs and assigns, the sum of one hundred dollars in money to be paid to her by my Executor hereinafter appointed, within twelve months after my decease, to be paid out of the residue of my estate, her Executor, administrators and assigns.
I give, devise and bequest to my beloved wife Cornelia Edwards all of my personal and mixed property, consisting of Household and Kitchen Furniture, Horses, Cows, Poultry, Eggs, Pigs, and all other property, and all other property of any kind and value, also all money in hand, or in bank, all Bank Stock, and all other accounts, and all other moneys of any and every kind due to (John L. Edwards) to have and to hold the same to her and her Executors, administrators and assigns forever.
I also give, devise and bequest to my said wife, the Farm a small tract of land situated in Shenandoah County, State of Virginia, and all other real estate belonging to me in said County and State, to have and to hold the same in fee simple to her and her Executors, administrators and assigns forever. I also give to my said wife, the two improvements and increase of my Farm in Bedford County, State of West Virginia, known as the Carroll Farm, to have and to hold the same to her and her assigns during the term of her widowhood or decease.
I give, devise and bequest to my Brother James E. Edwards of Bedford County, State of West Virginia, and Sister Charlotte M. Edwards of Shenandoah County, Virginia, my Farm in North Carolina, known as the Carroll Farm, and its appurtenances, and all the profits, increase, and advantages that may
