 ment, in manner and form following, that is to say,
 Item 1st, After my decease, I desire that all my just debts and
 funeral expenses be paid out of my Estate by my Executor
 hereinafter named.

Item 2nd, I give and bequeath my Clock to my Niece, Olyga R. J.
 Sykes. I give and bequeath to Franklin P. Pope, the sum of five
 dollars in Specie, and One hundred and fifty dollars in Currency,
 and my best hair Brunk. I give and bequeath to his Sister,
 Corina O. Pope, the balance of my Specie, and three hundred and fifty
 dollars in Currency. I also give her One bed, bedstead and all
 my bed clothes, or covers, and my largest trunk. I give my wearing
 apparel to Olyga R. J. Sykes, Corina O. Pope and Robert P. Pope to
 be equally divided between them. The balance of my household furniture
 I give and bequeath to said Olyga R. J. Sykes and Corina O. Pope, and
 the balance of my Estate consisting of money, bonds &c. I give and
 bequeath to said Olyga R. J. Sykes, Franklin P. Pope and Corina O. Pope,
 to be equally divided between them. Should my nephew Robert P.
 Pope, collect any money for me for the rent of my dower land, it is
 my will and desire that he shall not pay any interest thereon.
