As a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 20th day of January 1871,
 This writing bearing date the 9th day of September 1870, purporting to be the
 last will & Testament of Digo Pope dec. was then read & proved by the Oath
 of John M. Porter, One of the Subscribing witnesses thereto, and Thos B.
 Worrell & Rott McKendrick Barnes the two other Subscribing witnesses
 being dead, Wm. O. Briggs & B. O. Worrell were sworn as witnesses
 and declared that they were well acquainted with the handwriting
 of the said Thos B. Worrell, & Rott McKendrick Barnes, & were then
 that the names of the said Thos B. Worrell & Rott McKendrick Barnes
 to the said will subscribed, as witnesses, and in their own proper
 handwriting; Whereupon it is Ordered that the said writing bearing
 date as aforesaid be recorded as the true last will & Testament of
 the said Digo Pope dec. And on the Motion of Franklin P.
 Pope, the Executor thereof named, who made Oath according to
 Law, & testified against Binge O. Worrell his Security (who justified
 as Oath as to his Sufficiency,) entered into & acknowledged a bond
 in the penalty of Three Thousand dollars, conditioned as the Law directs
 Which bond is Ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted to
 the said Franklin P. Pope, for obtaining & proving the said
 Will in due form.
