There were several debts due by the decedent as Guardian, one of \$225⁰⁰ to J. P. Pope and one to Corinne O. Pope of \$300⁰⁰ which the Exr has paid in full, another due Robt A. Pope, has been recently come to his knowledge, and he has paid only \$155⁰⁰ thereon, but in a few months when Rents for present year & other sums due Est. can be collected he expects to pay off the whole indebtedness of the Est. will account therefor in next acc current.
