In the name of God Amen, I, Edwin Harris of the County Southampton
and State of Virginia, being of sound mind and of unimpaired body, and
being aware of the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the
time thereof do make this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all
former last wills and Testaments.

Item 1st I desire my body to be decently buried and all funeral exp-
enses paid.

Item 2nd After the payment of all my just debts which will be here-
inafter provided for I leave to Sally M. Marshens all of my Real
and personal Estate during her Natural life, and at her death to be
equally divided between her Children.

Item 3rd To provide for the payment of my debts, I desire that
the part of my Land formerly belonging to the Harris Tract, shall
be sold for that purpose.

Item 4th, In dividing the Land for the purpose above mentioned,
I desire the line dividing the Land in which I reside, (known
as the Garden Tract,) from the Land formerly belonging to the
Harris Tract, to be moved about fifty yards on to the last
mentioned Land across Holliday Branch, thence a straight
line to Plant Swamp. Witness my hand and Seal this 31st day
of July 1877.
